

GETTING TO KNOW YOU

WHAT TO SAY

Sometimes, it's hard to remember how much we have in common with each other. Let's take some time today seeing what we all have in common!

WHAT TO DO

Seat students in a circle

Pass the ball to a student, and ask a question about him or her (for example: What's your favorite movie? If you could go anywhere in the world, where would you go?)

Any student who likes the same thing stands up, and everyone finds a new seat in the circle

The student with the ball tosses it to someone else in the circle and the recreation leader asks a new question

Alternatives: If there is no ball, the rec leader can select a random student to start, and have the last student to sit down answer the next question

WHAT TO ASK

After the activity, these questions may guide discussion:

Who was surprised by the people who also had things in common with them?

What is a community?

How does this activity show what brings us together?
