

# ***SIMPLE MOSAIC***

## ***WHAT TO SAY***

When we work together, we can sometimes make something better or more interesting than what we could each make on our own.

As a community, we represent a diverse group of students with different interests, strengths, and values.

## ***WHAT TO DO***

Seat students in groups of 4

Each student gets a sheet of paper, which they fold in half, and in half again, to make 4 squares

Students begin in the top left square and draw anything they want (or they draw something according to a theme you select)

After a few minutes, prompt students to pass their paper to the student on their left or right

Each student draws something in the top right square of their new people

Repeat the process until each student in the group of 4 have contributed to every sheet of paper

## ***WHAT TO ASK***

After the activity, these questions may guide discussion:

Who wants to share their thoughts about how their mosaic turned out?

Who was really impressed by something someone in their group added?

What does the activity show about what students can accomplish by working in teams?
